INTRODUCTION

On August 29, 2024, TIBA hosted a session at the DADA GENGE Hub addressing sexual corruption among small-scale women vegetable and fruit vendors and farmers in Kinondoni and Ubungo, Dar es Salaam. Facilitated by Msafiri Mariam from SUKITA, the event identified common areas of sexual corruption, such as workplaces, markets, and local government offices. Participants discussed reporting channels, including gender desks, PCCB, TIBA, and related NGOs. The session aimed to raise awareness and combat sexual corruption through storytelling, songs, and messages, highlighting its detrimental impact on women's entrepreneurship, dignity, and health, particularly in spreading STDs.

BACKGROUND

On August 29, 2024, TIBA held a session at the DADA GENGE Hub addressing sexual corruption affecting women vendors and farmers in Kinondoni and Ubungo, Dar es Salaam. Facilitated by Msafiri Mariam from SUKITA, the event highlighted areas where sexual corruption occurs, such as workplaces, marketplaces, government offices, and bus stands. Participants discussed known reporting channels, including the police gender desk, TIBA, NGOs, and local government offices. The session aimed to raise awareness and combat sexual corruption through storytelling, music, and messaging, emphasizing its harmful impact on women's entrepreneurship, dignity, and health.
